We created four *Sanitation Stations* in the building: back of the Sanctuary, by front door, by the Glass Classroom, and in the Fellowship Hall. Each station has tissue, wipes, hand sanitizer, spray, gloves, and a trash can. All the restrooms have wipes and spray as well as encouraging words to wash your hands for at least 20 seconds.
